SCHEDULE A OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE - Export Inspection Council of India (EIC) was established under the Export (Quality Control and Inspection) Act 1963, to advise the Central Government on measures to be taken for EXPORT INSPECTION COUNCIL OF INDIA CONTENTS -

1. The Council shall be known as the Export Inspection Council of India.

2. The Council shall be a body corporate and shall have perpetual succession and a common seal.

3. The Council shall have the following members:—

(a) The Minister in charge of the Department of Commerce, Government of India; and

(b) One representative of the States and one representative of the Union Territories, to be nominated by the Government of India.
